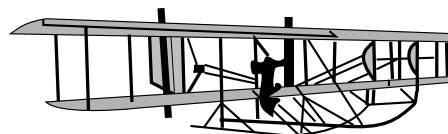

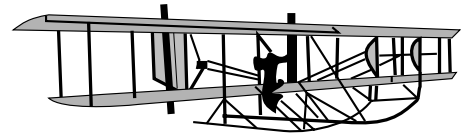
Prez Sayz

Minutes of the General Meeting, 3 May, 2005

Call to order: 8:00 PM by President Gerard Van Dijk.

Minutes of the General Meeting of 5 April, 2005 not approved as no call to do so.

Correspondence:

1) Publication from Transport Canada regarding changes to Air Space in Boundary Bay area.

2) Airworthiness Directive received from Transport Canada.

Committee Reports:

Treasury: Verbal report from Treasurer Don Souter. Advises as directed that there is currently \$ 702.43 in Building Fund. Added \$ 56.00 from Vern Little`s presentation this evening.

Membership: Rob Prior: 1 new member and 1 more re-upped. Total membership is 79 of whom 62 are dues paying types. Rob explained that these figures are "normal" for this time of year and that total membership will doubtless grow to the previous level as the year progresses.

Buildings, Library, VP, Aircraft:

No reports due as chairmen were absent.

Newsletter: Joan Cox apologizes for late May issue as she and Chris at Sun and Fun in Florida. She advises that next issue (June) will have all the information about Air Space changes in the Lower Mainland region.

Air Park Committee: Bruce Prior reports that the rezoning process to rezone the Air Park lands as a " Comprehensive Development" area continues slowly. DHAPCOM has submitted its plans for the future of the Air Park and GVRD Parks is now preparing a master drawing and written application.

DHAPCOM Management Group will meet in the Chapter 85 clubhouse at 1900 hrs on 24 May.

In response to a question, Bruce advises that MOGAS will not become available at the Air Park.

Program: Francois Leh: Fly In firm for Saturday, 2 July. Fly In Comm. meeting at 11:00 Sunday, 8 May following the Breakfast .

Vern Little will do his third presentation on electrics and avionics at the September GM.

Francois has a surprise presentation at our next GM. If no speaker is available at the next meeting Francois will demonstrate is hand standing skill and try not to have his cel` phone fall out of his pocket for once.

Old Business:

1) Tim Baker advises that we need to set a price for the Lazair. We have an offer of \$500 but apparently a flying Lazair will fetch about \$2000 these days.

2) Would the Chapter consider installing a Mode C in the Turbi? It would cost \$1200 to \$1500 including encoder. General consensus is that we don`t need it and can`t afford it!

3) Last year only 3 people showed up for the big Cleanup. This year`s cleanup scheduled for this Sunday with rain date for 15 May. Come . Bring tools. A few garden tools will be purchased for Chapter use.

4) Terry Elgood will be giving a seminar in Nanaimo on the regulations and paper work required for new home builts. One gem: Don`t stamp " Empty Weight" on the name plate. The weight may change and revising a name plate is a real pain. Also: Don`t call Amateur Builts " Experimental" They aren`t! That`s an Americanism that we don`t use!

Terry offered to do the same seminar at DHAP and it would be open to Chapter 85 members, other RAA members and anyone else who wants to come. It would be on a Saturday but no firm date set yet.

5) Nanaimo Flying Club Annual Fly In set for 18 June. Pancake breakfast and swap meet included.

6) To-night`s 50 / 50 Draw winner was Gerard who donated his winnings back to the Building Fund.
